

Confined Space – 1 day – Entry with escape breathing apparatus/refresher for experienced staff

Who should attend

A one day course suitable as a refresher for more experienced staff, or as an initial course for those who may need to enter spaces which, due to being substantially enclosed, may present a specified risk, but where a risk assessment has determined that operatives do not need to traverse long distances.

- Identification and hazards of confined spaces.
- Confined Space Regulations 1997, Approved Code of Practice and Water UK Guidance.
- Options for avoiding entry & basic risk assessment principles.
- Safe systems of work, including assessing atmospheres using gas detection/oxygen deficiency monitors.
- Personal protection and rescue equipment requirements where entry is necessary.
- Use of escape breathing apparatus.
- Electrical equipment requirements for potentially explosive atmospheres.
- Testing regimes for equipment.
- Emergency plans.
- Communication requirements.
- Medical and training requirements for staff entering confined spaces.

Booking Details

Practical session requires personal protection including overalls, safety boots, gloves, hard hat, knee pads. Customers are encouraged to use their own equipment for staff familiarity (escape sets etc), providing it is tested & in good condition. Courses start at approximately 8:45am till approximately 4:30pm

Course requirements and limitations

As outlined in Water UK Occasional Guidance note: ie medical standard required for car licence. Some sessions will take place in low light level/confined areas. Not suitable for those who may have to rescue other team members. Risk Assessment input is not sufficient to act as 'responsible person'
